



Screening Exams by Tech's


This module lists the number of screening exams done by technologist. It allows you to scan by time frame and site. It also lists the total number of bookings and no-shows.

*This module only lists the number of <u>screening exams</u> done, not diagnostic. For the number of diagnostic exams performed by technologist use the "Diagnostic Exams by Technologist" module.



Diagnostic Exams by Technologist

This module lists the number of diagnostic exams done by technologist. It allows you to scan by time frame and site. It also lists the total number of bookings and no-shows.




Booking Utilization Statistics

This listing allows users to run statistics for the number of seats allotted in the Booking Calendar per day and how many of those seats were booked.

Under each Site you can choose between screening, diagnostic, work-up's, ultrasounds and core bookings.

*Keep in mind that these unbooked seats may represent same day cancellations or changes to the schedule so they won't 100% reflect why the seats might not be booked.




Radiology Summary

This listing displays the total number of screening mammograms a radiologist has reported (PS Total). The screening mammograms are further broken down into the number of double and triple reads they have reported (2nd and 3rd read).

The last column displays the number of diagnostic mammograms a radiologist has reported.

At the bottom of the screen you will see the number of screening mammograms a technologist has flagged as highly suspicious and the number of unofficial/manual double reads the TA has flagged.



Procedures Listing

This listing shows both screening and diagnostic procedures done at a particular site for the specified time range.

Under the header "Total Records" there is a summary of the total number of procedures attended and the number of no-shows.
